1. The Council met 5 times in 2002 in the Crypt at St Andrew's Roseville.

3. Four new members jointed the Council in November 2002, following the retirement of those marked * - The Rev Ross Nicholson, Mrs Jan Hall, Mr Dugald Mackenzie and Mr Murray Maxwell.

Highlights

- 4. Ms Roslyn Allibone was appointed Bishop's Secretary from 14 January 2002.
- 5. Evangelism Council entered into a training agreement with the Rev Stuart Robinson of Evangelism Ministries and set aside a grant of \$18,000. It was resolved that EM commence a coaching consultancy covering 15 parishes over 3 years (2003-2005). The target parishes for 2003 would be Hornsby Heights, Normanhurst, West Ryde, Seaforth and Greenwich.
- 6. Karen Eastment from Youthworks was appointed Children's Ministry Consultant.
- 7. A successful Regional Dinner was held at Gordon Rugby Club on 20 February with 218 people present representing most of our 64 parishes. Bishop Glenn Davies addressed the dinner with a challenging message.
- 8. A new Area Deanery of Willoughby was created, comprising the parishes of Chatswood, Mowbray, Roseville East, Willoughby, East Willoughby, Lane Cove, Longueville, Artarmon and Northbridge.
- 9. North Ryde relinquished the part-time chaplaincy at Macquarie University and was able to continue as a provisional parish without the annual grant of \$20,000.
- 10. It was resolved not to extend John Clewer's contract as Children/Families Worker beyond the end of 2002.

- 11. The Parish of Denistone East/Marsfield was changed to Macquarie Parish with the Archbishop's approval.
- 12. Work began among Farsi speaking people at St Paul's Chatswood funded by an Anglicare welfare grant of \$8,000.
- 13. Our gratitude was recorded for the service of the Rev Ken Yapp, Dr Kim Hawtrey (continuing evangelism in the region) and Mr Jim Keith (Secretary), wishing Ken and Jim much blessing in their retirement.
- 14. Appreciation also for Dr Barry Newman and the Rev John Dickson as itinerant evangelists in the region, and Archdeacon Reg Platt for his co-ordination of the regional evangelists.
