AN ORDINANCE to amend "The St. Paul's Sydney Land Resumption Ordinance 1911."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The St. Paul's Sydney Land Resumption Ordinance 1911" by making further and other provision for the place of erection of the School-house and Hall and by varying certain trusts as to the same. NOW THEREFORE the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all powers vested in the said Synod by the "Church of England Property Act of 1889" ordains declares directs and rules as follows:—

(1) That after the letter "(c)" in clause 3 the letter "(d)" be inserted.

2. That the following words be added at the end of clause 3:—"and accordingly that any such building or buildings may be erected wholly within one of the said unresumed parts or partly within one and partly within the other of the said unresumed parts."
