## 18

An Ordinance to vary the trusts declared by the "St Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance of 1920" and to amend the said Ordinance and to repeal the "Bowral Church of England Grammar School for Boys Ordinance of 1924" and for other purposes incidental thereto.

WHEREAS the "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance .. of 1920" provided inter alia that certain moneys should be applied by the Archbishop for the time being of the Diocese of Sydney for the purpose of acquiring land in the Parish of Boyral and in or towards establishing thereon a Church of England Crammar School for Boys to be vested and managed under a Coustitution as provided by the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney. AND WHERE-AS in pursuance of such Ordinance the said Archbishop acquired 43 acres 3 roods 36 perches being lots 1, 2, 3 and 27 of Runnymeade Estate Bowral and being the whole of the land comprised in Certificates of Title under the Real Property Act 1900 regisered Volume 3547 Folio 122 and Volume 1212 Folio 13 respectively for the purpose aforesaid the said land being vested in the said Archbishop. AND WHEREAS by the "Bowral Church of England Grammar School for Boys Ordinance of 1924" a school known as the "Church of England Grammar School for Boys" was duly constituted at Bowral as therein mentioned AND WHEREAS by the "Tudor House School Ordinance of 1925" a school known as the "Tudor House School" was acquired and the Government of the same vested in a Council consisting of amongst others the Rector for the time being of the Parish of St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral AND WHEREAS the Tudor House School is situate at Moss Vale distant six miles from Bowral and it is no longer expedient to carry on the Church of England Grammar School for Boys at Bowral AND WHEREAS by virtue of the establishment of the Tudor House School at Moss Vale and the School at Bowral being no longer required it is expedient to use the Bowral land so acquired together with certain moneys as hereinafter mentioned for the purposes of a school for girls at Bowral AND WHEREAS by the "Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Ordinance of 1895" since amended

1. The 43 acres 3 roods 36 perches of land being lots 1, 2, 3 and 27 of Runnymeade Estate Bowral and being the whole of

the land comprised in Certificates of Title under the Real Property Act 1900 registered Volume 3547 Folio 122 and Volume 1212 Folio 13 respectively now vested in the Archbishop of Sydney for the purposes of the Church of Ingland Grammar School for Boys at Bowral shall on the passing of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby vested in the said Archbishop of Sydney for the purposes of the Sydney Church of England Grammar School for girls in lieu of the Church of England Grammar School for Boys Bowral.

- 2 The ore-half share of the remaining proceeds mentioned in sub-section b clause 4 of the "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance of 1920" shall on the parsing of this Ordinance (subject to deducting thereout all the costs charges expenses of and incidental to the Bowral Church of England Grammar School for Boys Ordinance and this Ordinance and the said sum of £213 18s. 3d.) be paid to the Council of the Sydney Church of England Grammar School for Girls for the general purposes of the said School and the receipt of the treasurer for the time being of the said Council shall be a sufficient discharge for the said payment.
- 3. The "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Ordinance of 1920" is hereby further amended as follows:—By deleting subsection c clause 4 and substituting the following:—
  - (c) The other half of the said proceeds shall be invested in manner hereinafter mentioned and the nett income arising therefrom (with the exception of the proceeds of the land described in the Schedule hereto) applied as follows:—A sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty pounds per annum to be paid to the Minister for the time being of the said Church and the balance used in the following manne::—Half for the Home Mission Society of the Diocese of Sydney and half for the Church Parsonage or Parish Hall purposes within the Parish of Bowral the receipt of the Rector and Churchwardens for the time being of the said Church being a sufficient discharge for such half.
  - (d) The income of the proceeds of the land described in the Schedule hereto shall be paid to the Rector and Churchwardens for the time being of the Church of

## 4 St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Further Amending

- St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral whose receipt shall be a sufficient discharge and be by them applied for the purpose of repairing remodelling and/or extending the church and/or rectory buildings in the said Parish.
- 4. The payment of £213 18s. 3d. already made to the Rector of St. Simon and St. Jude out of the capital sum referred to in subsection c clause 4 of the aforesaid Ordinance is hereby confirmed but such capital sum shall be repaid the said sum of £213 18s. 3d. referred to in clause 2 of this Ordinance.
- 5. The "Bowral Church of England Grammar School for Boys Ordinance of 1924" is hereby repealed but such repeal shall not invalidate anything done under the said Ordinance.
- 6. This Ordinance may be cited as the "St. Simon and St. Jude Bowral Sale Varying and Repealing Grammar School Ordinance of 1926."

## THE SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

All that piece or parcel of land containing 1 acre 3 roods 157 perches being part of "The Glebe' land at Bowral in the Parish of Mittagong County of Cauden and State of New South Wales Commencing at a point on the West side of Edward Street bearing North distant 66 feet from the North West corner of Lot 3 of Section C of "The Glebe" Subdivision being D.P. 11838 and bounded thence on the East by Edward Street being a line bearing North distant 356 feet 84 inches thence by a line bearing 315 degrees 0 minutes distant 14 feet 18 inches to the South side of Boolway Street thence by that side of that street being a line bearing West distant 132 feet 2 inches and again by a line bearing 296 degrees 46 minutes distant 82 feet 84 inches thence on the West by a line bearing South distant 403 feet 114 inches and thence on the South by a line bearing East distant 216 feet to the point of commencement be the several dimensions hereinbefore mentioned a little more or less.
