ST. THOMAS! NORTH SYDNEY ORDINANCE 1984

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the sale of certain land at Sydney Road, Manly and to vary trusts and to provide for the investment of the proceeds thereof pon the same-trusts.

## WHEREAS

- Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney formerly known as Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter called "the Corporate Trustee") is seized in fee simple of the land and property described in the Schedule hereto. The said property is church trust property held by the Corporate Trustee upon certain trusts declared in the Will of the late Francis Paul Couch Morris of "Dane Hollow", Pittwater Road, Pymble in the State of New South Wales, Gentleman, which trusts are as follows, that is to say to pay from time to time the whole of the net income of the said property (therein referred to as "the Trust Fund") to the Rector for the time being of St. Thomas' Church North Sydney for or towards his living and support and it was further declared that if for any reason the trustee shall at any time be unable lawfully to apply the Trust Fund and the income therefrom for the purposes aforesaid then it was directed that the Trust Fund shall be dealt with and applied for the use and benefit of the Anglican Church of Australia as shall be declared by Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney under the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act, 1917 or any statutory amendment or re-enactment thereof and it was further declared that the Trust Fund shall be deemed church trust
- C. The said Francis Paul Couch Morris died on 19th January, 1948 and Probate of his said Will was granted by the Supreme Court of New South Wales in its Probate Jurisdiction on 29th July, 1948.
- D. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ulin the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY DECLARES RULES
ORDAINS AND DIRECTS as follows:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Thomas' North Sydney Ordinance 1984".
- 2. By reason of the circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts upon which the said land is held, it is inaped to carry out a character that the said property be sold.
- 3. The Corporate Trustee is hereby empowered to sell the said property within three years after the date of assent to this Ordinance and thereafter only with the consent of the Standing Committee by public auction or private contract in one or more lots and for such price or prices and upon and subject to such terms and conditions as the Corporate Trustee may determine freed from the trusts upon which the said property is now held.
- 4. The proceeds arising from the sale of the said property after payment of the costs and expenses of and incidental to this Ordinance and the sale and conveyance in pursuance hereof (hereinafter called "the Trust Fund") shall be invested as hereinafter provided by the Corporate Trustee and held by it upon

- 5. The Corporate Trustee shall have in addition to its existing the powers the following powers:
  - (a) to invest the Trust Fund in whole or in part in any of the forms of investment approved for the investment of property by the investment of Church Trust Property

  - (b) to vary any such investments from time to time; and
  - (c) to sell any such inventments from time to time, to pay any costs and expenses of and incidental to such sale
