Standing Committee Ordinance 1897-1978 Amending Ordinance 1984

No.26 1984

AN ORDINANCE to amond the Standing Committee Ordinance 1897-1978 in certain respects.

Whereas it is expedient that rules be made as to the extent to which notice shall be given to members of the Standing Committee of meetings of the Standing Committee and as to the quorum for a meeting of the Standing Committee.

NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DIRECTS DECLARES AND RULES as follows:

10 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the "Standing Committee Ordinance 1897-1978 Amending Ordinance 1984".

(2) The Standing Committee Ordinance 1997-1978 is hereinafter

(2) The Standing Committee Ordinance 1897-1978 is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Ordinance".

(3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cried as the "Standing Committee Ordinance 1897-1984" and clause 11 thereof is amended accordingly.

All ordinances made by, resolutions passed by, and other acts of the Standing Committee are ratified and confirmed notwiths standing either or both of the following:

(a) that no notice or inadequate notice may have been given to one or more members of the Standing Committee of any one or more meetings of the Standing Committee;
 (b) that a quorum may not have been present at one or more meetings of the Standing Committee or at any part thereof.

3. The Principal Ordinance is amanded by the substitution of the following for clause 6.

"(1) A notice of a meeting of the Standing Committee may be given to a member verbally or by serving it on him personally or by sending it by post or through a document exchange to the address supplied by him for the giving of notices to him but, if no address has been supplied by a member to the secretary or acting agentitary of the Standing Committee, then to the address which is believed by the person giving the notice to be the place of business or of work or of residence of that member.

(2) Where a notice is sent by post or by a document exchange, service shall be deemed to be effected by properly addressing prepaying (in the case of a notice sent by post) and posting or otherwise appropriately dispatching the notice and to have been effected on the day next following the day (neither day being a Saturday, Sunday or public notiday) after the date of its posting or dispatch.
