## STANDING ORDERS AMENDMENT.

*(As Passed.)*

## AMENDMENT OF STANDING ORDERS.

Order of Business for the first day of each Session of Synod:—

9. (k) Motions which shall have been received by the Standing Committee from Members of Synod at least one month before the Session of Synod provided that no Member shall send to the Standing Committee more than two such motions.

Order of Business for the second and succeeding days of each Session of Synod:—

11. (g) Motions according to order of notice or in the order as settled by a Committee of the Synod elected at the opening of each Synod or as ordered by vote of Synod under Standing Order No. 41.

*Motions Lapsed.*

41. Motions shall be taken in the order in which they stand, and if not then made, unless postponed by leave of the Synod, shall be considered as having lapsed. Provided that the order of any motion with the consent of the mover may be varied at any time by motion without notice and without debate.
