## WEST PENNANT HILLS ORDINANCE 1983

## No. 39, 1983

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the mortgaging of certan land at West Pennant Hills.

## WHEREAS:

- A. Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (here-inafter referred to as the "Corporate Trustee") proposes to acquire the land described in the schedule hereto.
- B. It is expedient that the said land be mortgaged to secure the repayment of moneys borrowed to meet the balance of the purchase price payable in respect of the same.

  NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY DECLARES ORDAINS DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:-
- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as "West Pennant Hills Ordinance 1983".
- 2. (1) The Standing Committee hereby directs that, upon the land described in the schedule hereto becoming Church Trust Property held for the Diocese of Sydney, the said land may be mortgaged for the purpose of borrowing such amount as may be needed to meet the balance of the purchase price payable therefor and all costs in connection with the acquisition of the same by the Corporate Trustee.
- (2) Whilst any money is secured by any mortgage grant or pursuant to this Ordinance, the Churchwardens of St.

  Matthews Church, West Pennant Hills, in every statement of assets prepared pursuant to Clause 41 of the Sydney Church Ordinance 1912 (as amended) shall disclose the amount so secured on the last day of the financial year to which the statement of assets relates.

## SCHEDULE

The land in Certificate of Title Volume 6919 Folio 80 known as 3 New Line Road, West Pennant Hills, comprising Lot A2 on Plan lodged with Transfer G150039.
