AN ORDINANCE to amend Clause 12 of the Abbotsleigh College Ordinance of 1924.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Abbotsleigh College Ordinance of 1924 to provide for the retirement of certain members of the Council. Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. Clause 12 of the "Abbotsleigh College Ordinance of 1924" is hereby repealed and the following clause substituted therefor:—

"12. At each ordinary Session of Synod five of the ten members of the Council appointed by Synod shall retire from office of whom three shall be laymen and two women but shall be eligible for re-appointment. Such members shall retire in rotation according to the length of time of office. Provided that, where members have held office for an equal period of time the member or members to retire shall be determined by ballot taken amongst such retiring members."

2. Such repeal shall not affect any matter or thing done under or pursuant to the repealed clause.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Abbotsleigh College (Further Amendment) Ordinance of 1944."
