

ANGLICAN COUNSELLING CENTRE CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1991

No 31, 1991

An Ordinance to amend Anglican Counselling Centre Constitution Ordinance 1963.

A. The Anglican Counselling Centre (hereinafter called the "Organisation") has hitherto carried out its objects in accordance with the terms of the Anglican Counselling Centre Constitution Ordinance 1963 (hereinafter called the "Principal Ordinance") within the Diocese of Sydney.

B. The Organisation is an approved Anglican organisation to conduct marriage and family counselling with government financial assistance.

C. The Organisation has been informed that government funding for its work cannot be made available in future unless the Organisation indicates its agreement to certain guidelines for organisations seeking approval to conduct programmes of marriage counselling, family mediation or marriage education in particular in relation to the selection of staff.

D. It is considered desirable that the terms of the Principal Ordinance be amended so as to enable such government funding to be made available.

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:

1. Paragraph (ii) of clause 3 of the Principal Ordinance shall be amended by the deletion of the words "of Christian conviction and affiliation" and the substitution of the words "who share the same values as the Anglican Church of Australia".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Anglican Counselling Centre Constitution Amendment Ordinance 1991".
