## No. 7, 1934.

An Ordinance to amend the "Archbishop Enabling Ordinance 1916."

Whereas by the "Archbishop Enabling Ordinance 1910" it was provided that the Archbishop of Sydney should ex officio be an additional member of all bodies elected by the Synod other than certain bodies therein specified AND Whereas it is expedient to provide that the Bishop Coadjutor should when the Archbishop so desires act as his deputy to attend meetings of the said bodies and for such purpose to amend the said Ordinance The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

1. The "Archbishop Enabling Ordinance 1910" is hereby amended by inserting at the end of clause one thereof the following proviso:—

Provided that the Bishop Coadjutor may at the request of the Archbishop act as his deputy for the purposes of this Ordinance in respect of those bodies of which the Bishop Coadjutor is not ex officio or by election a member.

This Ordinance may be styled and cited as the "Archbishop Enabling Ordinance 1910 Amendment Ordinance 1934."
