AN ORDINANCE amending the St. Peter's Woolloomooloo Mortgaging Ordinance of 1931 and for other purposes.

Whereas by St. Peter's Woolloomooloo Mortgaging Ordinance of 1931 (hereinafter called the principal ordinance) Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney was authorised to obtain an advance of money not exceeding the sum of £500 on the security of the lands described in the Schedule to the principal Ordinance and to mortgage the said lands for such purpose AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the principal ordinance in manner hereinafter appearing and to make the further provision hereinafter contained Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by the Land Ordinance Procedure and Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1926 and in pursuance of the powers vested in Synod by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and in the place of the said Synod Ordains declares directs and rules as follows:-

- 1. The words "one thousand" are hereby substituted for the words "five hundred" in Section One of the principal Ordinance.
- 2. The amounts borrowed pursuant to the authority of the principal ordinance as amended by this Ordinance shall be applied in paying such of the liabilities of the Parish of St. Peter's Woolloomooloo as the Standing Committee shall direct.

3. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as St. Peter's Woolloomooloo Mortgaging Ordinance of 1933.
