

ST. PHILIP'S SYDNEY ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1983

No. 191 1983

AN ORDINANCE to further amend Ordinance No. 22 of 1975 entitled "St. Philip's Sydney Ordinance 1975" (as subsequently amended).

WHEREAS pursuant to Clause 5 of the St. Philip's Sydney Ordinance 1975 as amended (hereinafter called the "existing Ordinance") a proportion of the income derived by Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter called "the Corporate Trustee") was directed to be paid annually by the Corporate Trustee to the Churchwardens of the Parish of St. Philip's Sydney to be applied by them for the purposes therein set forth AND WHEREAS the arrangement envisaged by that Clause has become financially ^{inexpedient and unworkable} ~~unworkable~~ AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the said Clause be amended AND insofar as such amendment may further vary the trusts, upon which the Corporate Trustee holds the balance referred to in Clause 5 of the existing Ordinance, to vary now the same and make the further provisions hereinafter contained NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY DECLARES ORDAINS AND DIRECTS as follows:-

1. By reason of the circumstances hereinbefore recited it has become inexpedient to carry out and observe the trusts declared in the existing Ordinance to the extent (if any) to which such trusts are hereby varied and it is expedient (so far as it may be a variation of trusts) that the said trusts be varied further and as hereinafter set forth.

2. The existing Ordinance is hereby further amended by inserting the following:-

"5A. (1) Subject to Clause 4 but as soon as possible after this Clause 5A takes effect and not

withstanding Clause 5 the Corporate Trustee shall realise from the Balance a sufficient sum to repay the loan granted by Westpac Banking Corporation (formerly Bank of New South Wales) to the Churchwardens of St. Philip's Sydney for the restoration of the Church building and discharge the said debt.

(2) Subject to Clause 4 hereof the Corporate Trustee shall apply all income derived by it from the Balance or so much thereof as shall remain after the deduction of amount referred to in sub-clause (1) (whether before or after the date on which this Clause 5A takes effect) annually for the benefit of any one or more of the following in such proportions as the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney may from time to time by resolution determine:-

- (a) educational purposes within the Diocese of Sydney;
- (b) inner City parishes as defined in the Inner City Ordinance 1972-1973 (as amended);
- (c) special purposes assessment grants as determined by the Synod;
- (d) the restoration of historic church buildings within the Diocese of Sydney.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Philip's Sydney Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1983". The existing ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "St. Philip's Sydney Ordinance 1975-1983".
