## St. Philip's Glebe Land Supplemental of 1924.

An Ordinance to supplement Sections three and nine of "St. Philip's Glebe Land Vesting Management Ordinance 1920."

WHEREAS by Section three of St. Philip's Glebe Land Vesting Management Ordinance 1920 (hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance") provision is made for the constitution and election of a Board of Trustees consisting of seven members but no provision is made by such Ordinance for filling vacancies in the office of such Board of Trustees and it is expedient to make provision with regard thereto AND WHEREAS by Section nine of the Principal Ordinance it is provided that the rents profits or other income derived from the Glebe lands referred to in the said Ordinance after certain payments thereout should be applied as therein provided to an amount not exceeding Seven hundred pounds for each period of twelve months from the thirty-first day of March then next ensuing until otherwise determined by Ordinance of Synod and that the remainder if any of the said income should be invested and accumulated and held upon the trusts to be thereafter determined by Ordinance of AND WHEREAS by St. Philip's Glebe Land Amending and Supplemental Ordinance 1920 it was directed that the aforesaid remainder of the said income as from the thirty-first day of December 1920 should be held and applied upon the trusts declared by the said St. Philip's Glebe Land Amending and Supplemental Ordinance 1920 AND WHEREAS at such thirty-first day of December 1920 there were accumulations of the said remainder of the said income amounting to Four thousand five hundred and sixty-three pounds fourteen shillings and five pence and no provision was made by the said Amending Ordinance of 1920 for the application of such sum AND WHEREAS such accumulations have in fact been invested with other moneys forming part of the Trust Funds controlled by the Board referred to in the Principal Ordinance and the principal and interest thereof are computed to amount to the sum of Five thousand six hundred and seventy pounds as at the fifteenth day of October 1924 AND WHEREAS it is expedient that such last mentioned sum-shall be held upon the trusts and applied as is hereinafter provided. Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the man-

agement and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Triest Property Act 1917 and of all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains directs and rules as follows:—

- 1. The Standing Committee is hereby appointed for the purpose of exercising and accordingly may during the recess of the Synod of the Diocese exercise in place of such Synod all or any of the powers and functions and do and make all or any of the things referred to in Section 14 part 3 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 so far as regards a vacancy or vacancies in the office of trustee on the Board of Trustees referred to in the Principal Ordinance.
- 2. The sum of Five thousand six hundred and seventy rounds part of the Trust funds controlled by the said Board of Trustees shall be applied as and when the said Board in its discretion may decide for the purposes or any one or more of the purposes mentioned in Section seven of the Principal Ordinance and the balance (it any) of the accumulation of the remainder of the said income at the thirty-first day of December 1920 as hereinbeford mentioned and the produce thereof shall be applied as is directed by the said Amending Ordinance of 1920 with regard to the remainder (if any) of the income referred to in Section nine of the Principal Ordinance.
- 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "St. Philip's Glebe Land Supplemental Ordinance of 1924,"
