Standing Committee Amendment Ordinance 1991

No 44, 1991

An Ordinance to amend the Standing Committee Ordinance 1897 (the "Principal Ordinance").

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Principal Ordinance.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains as follows -

Citation

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Standing Committee Amendment Ordinance 1991".

Amendment: Delegation Provisions

- 2. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the following subclause after subclause 4(4) -
 - "(5) The Standing Committee may from time to time resolve that any of its business (other than the making of ordinances, the making of appointments or the filling of casual vacancies) be determined by PARC, WARC or a committee or committees having members –
 - (a) who are appointed from time to time by the Standing Committee; and
 - (b) who hold office for such terms and in accordance with such conditions as the Standing Committee may specify; and
 - (c) not less than two-thirds of whom are Standing Committee members."
