FURTHER AMENDMENT OF STANDING ORDER No. 41.

Motions Lapsed.

41. Provided also that Synod may at any Session resolve without notice and without debate that any specified motion on the Business Paper shall not be considered at such Session except in the presence of at least the numbers of Members, Clerical and Lay, as are specified in such Resolution and the said Motion shall be considered as having lapsed if at any time during the consideration of the same the number of Clerical or Lay members so specified shall not be present. Provided also that during any proposal or debate of a motion the President of Synod either of his own motion or at the suggestion of any member of Synod may declare that in his opinion such motion ought not to be considered in a thin house and thereupon the Synod shall be counted and if fewer than 30 Clerical members or 30 Lay members be present such motion shall stand postponed to the next day of sitting, or if it be the last day of the Session the motion shall lapse.
