Standing Orders Amendment Ordinance 1978

An Ordinance to amend the Standing Orders for the conducting of business coming before the Synod.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the rules known as Standing Orders

WHEREAS It is expedient to amend the rules known as Standing Orders contained in the Schedule to the Standing Orders Amendment and Consolidation Ordinance 1968-1975 (hereinafter called the "Principal Ordinance") NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as "Standing Orders Amendment Ordinance 1978".

(2) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "Standing Orders Ordinance 1968-1978" and in any reprint of that Ordinance clause 3 shall be amended accordingly.
