

Synod (National Church Life Survey) Special Application Ordinance 2011

No 19, 2011

Long Title

An Ordinance to vary the trusts on which certain property held for the Synod is held to permit the application of an amount for the purposes of the National Church Life Survey.

Preamble

A. The Sydney Diocesan Secretariat (the Secretariat) holds certain church trust property on behalf of the Synod in a fund known as Synod Fund 129 (the Synod Fund).

B. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Synod Fund is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient to vary those trusts to the extent necessary to permit the application of up to \$100,000 from the Synod Fund for the purposes of the National Church Life Survey (NCLS).

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Synod (National Church Life Survey) Special Application Ordinance 2011.

2. Declaration

By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Synod Fund is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient to vary the trusts to the extent necessary to permit the application under clause 3.

3. Application

The Secretariat is to pay an amount or amounts totalling up to \$100,000 from the Synod Fund for the purposes of NCLS in accordance with the written direction of the Registrar.
