*Synod Representative Amending Ordinance 1958.*

AN ORDINANCE to amend The Synod Representative Ordinance of 1945.

WHEREAS by the 8th and 10th Constitutions contained in the Schedule to The Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902 the Synod of a Diocese is empowered to make other provision for the summoning of clergymen and the electing of representatives to Synod.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the representation on Synod of certain Provisional Parishes formerly styled "Parochial Districts" and not entitled hitherto to such representation,

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the Powers conferred upon it by the said Act for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Synod Representative Amending Ordinance 1958."

2. (a) The Synod Representative Ordinance of 1945 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(b) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Synod Representative Ordinance 1945-58."

3. Section 1 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion of the figure "(1)" after the figure "1" at the commencement of the section and by the addition of the following new sub-section:—

"(2) A Provisional Parish formed under the provisions of the Parishes and Provisional Districts Ordinance 1925 as amended shall be deemed a separate cure of souls for the purpose of Synod Representation.
