

TRINITY GRAMMAR SCHOOL CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1989

No 6, 1989

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trinity Grammar School Constitution Ordinance 1928.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Trinity Grammar School Constitution Ordinance 1928 (the "Principal Ordinance").

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod **HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES** as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Trinity Grammar School Constitution Amendment Ordinance 1989".
2. Insert in clause 17A of the Principal Ordinance the words "or without" after the word "within".
3. Immediately after clause 17 of the Principal Ordinance, the following new clause is to be inserted:

"17AA. The said Council may acquire lands and premises additional to those described in the First and Second Schedules hereto when and where it may deem it expedient so to do in the interests of Trinity Grammar School or of church education."
